• Current Outbreak

- Grace Manor was declared to be in outbreak by Peel Public Health on December 31.
 All Home Units were placed on droplet contact with airborne precaution status
- Currently 4 residents have tested positive with 47 test results pending; 29 staff have tested positive with 24 test results pending and 2 caregivers positive
- There have been significant delays in receiving PCR test results
- PPE audits are being conducted throughout the homes. All staff and caregivers are being provided N-95 masks

• Testing and Vaccines

- Daily RAT testing is mandatory for all staff and caregivers
- 4th dose boosters are being provided to all residents. Kamal Khera (MP for Brampton South and Federal Minister of Seniors) will be volunteering to help with boosters. Ms. Khera volunteered at Grace Manor during the first-wave outbreak in April 2020.

Impacts of Isolation / Confinement

 Because Grace Manor is in declared outbreak, residents are currently confined to their rooms and communal dining has been suspended. The impacts of isolation are a concern for us all. Caregivers should speak to the Charge Nurse on your home unit if

- you would like to take your loved ones outside their room; Activation staff are also available on every floor to help take residents for a walk outside their rooms;
- Admin is supporting a family member's request to Peel Public Health that two
 essential caregivers living in the same household be given permission to visit their
 loved one together (instead of visiting one at a time as per the current Ministry
 guidelines)
- Admin is also supporting requests of several families to allow married couples living on the same home unit to be able to see one another during the outbreak
- Family Council has sent an open letter to Peel Public Health requesting that
 volunteers (triple vaxxed) be allowed back in to help residents during mealtimes –
 thereby providing company to residents who are confined to their rooms and
 supporting staff, many of whom are off sick.
- A big thank you to Jessica for all her hard work with GM and wish her all the success on her new position and spending more time with family. Justine Dudziak steps into her new role as Grace Manor administrator on Monday January 17.
