

Essential Caregiver Visits at Faith Manor

- One caregiver may visit a resident on the Resident Home Area between visiting hours for an unlimited amount of time between the hours of 9am to 9pm.

Important note: to ensure appropriate screening of staff at shift change and to allow for social distancing, <u>essential care givers are not able to enter to visit</u> <u>between the hours of 1pm to 3pm</u>. If you are already in the home during these hours, then you can stay in the home and continue your visit, however no new essential caregiver will be permitted to enter during this 2-hour time slot. End of Life visitors are excluded from this requirement.

- Overnight stays are not permitted and you must stay in your loved ones room. No eating or drinking permitted in your loved ones room. Masks and Shields must be worn at all times while visiting.
- Please note, you can only use the washroom outside of the home on the ground floor across from the Covenant Tower cafe.
- All essential caregivers will be screened at Covenant Tower entrance and will undergo Rapid Antigen Testing upon point of entry. Essential Caregivers will be required to have a NEGATIVE Rapid Antigen Test BEFORE they are permitted entry into Faith Manor. The Rapid Antigen testing will take about 20 minutes.
- No personal belongings such as jackets or purses will be allowed into the home, personal belongings can be kept in a designated locker, please bring your own lock.
- All outside items coming into the home for residents will require a 3 days quarantine in keeping with our usual process.

Only 2 essential caregivers may be designated per resident, this must be submitted in writing. Please remember that only 1 caregiver can visit at a time due to the current restrictions in the region of Peel.
