1.0 Family Council Ontario (FCO) presentation	 Speaker: Ms. Tiffany Fearon from FCO (a not-for profit funded by the Ministry of Long Term Care) presented an overview of the scope of what Family Councils can do under the Long-Term Care Homes Act. Her presentation outlined: the core purpose of family council (support, teamwork, education, advocacy); best practices for maintaining an effective group (setting a welcoming tone; encouraging active exchange and participation; creating terms of reference; setting protocols around confidentiality); governance models; leadership models; elections and succession planning; code of conduct and conflict resolution; examples of how Family Councils can connect with other Family Councils to share information and solve problems; and examples of effective FC advocacy to promote structural change in the LTC sector. 		
	FCO is avaialable as a support to provide resources and facilitate connections to other Family Councils or other actors in the LTC sector.
