

Mental Health First Aid for Seniors (In-Person)

The MHFA Seniors is an adaptation of the MHFA Basic course. It is a 2-day course that is intended to increase the capacity of seniors, families (informal caregivers), friends, staff in care settings and communities to promote mental health in seniors, prevent mental illness and suicide wherever possible in seniors and intervene early when problems first emerge.

Seniors Mental Health First Aid Substance-related disorders Mood-related disorders Anxiety and trauma-related disorders Dementia Delirium Psychosis

Crisis First Aid Skills Learned

* Substance overdose * Suicidal behaviour * Panic attack * Acute stress reaction * Psychotic episode * Delirium
