Testing Requirements

• When the home is in outbreak, Public Health may require additional testing requirements, which will be communicated at the screening point.



Essential Caregivers

Residents (or the residents substitute decision maker if resident is not capable) may **designate FOUR** (4) **essential caregivers.** A resident and/or their substitute decision-maker may not continuously change a designation in order to increase the number of people able to enter the home. Visits are limited to 4 people at a time per resident (when home is not in outbreak). **ALL Designated Essential Caregivers** will be actively screened and tested as per the testing requirements above.

TOWERS (INDEPENDENT/ASSISTED LIVING):

- ❖ Masks/face coverings are no longer required, but are still recommended to be worn in common areas of HCH.
- ❖ Visitors experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or those who have come into contact with someone suspected of having COVID-19 should not visit HCH.
- Even if you have been vaccinated it is very important that you continue to follow all public health recommendations. Vaccination does not guarantee that you will not get COVID-19, the vaccines protect you from developing severe illness and hospitalization associated with COVID-19 illness. This means that although the risk is reduced, it is still possible for you to get COVID-19 and spread it to other people.
