

GRACE AND FAITH MANOR - ORGANIZATIONAL UPDATE LAST UPDATE: June 9, 2025

GRACE MANOR:

- **As of June 6, 2025, a confirmed Respiratory Outbreak (Human Metapneumovirus) was declared on 1 South (Tulip Terrace) neighborhood.**
- **General visitors** are postponed. Essential Caregivers (who have no respiratory symptoms) are allowed to visit Tulip Terrace at this time but will be asked to wear a mask and follow IPAC practices while visiting.

FAITH MANOR:

- **As of May 26, 2025, Public Health has declared a Confirmed Respiratory Outbreak (Covid-19 Cases) on the 2nd floor/neighbourhood. On May 30th, the outbreak has been extended to the 3rd floor/Lighthouse neighbourhood as per recommendations from Public Health.**
- **General visitors are <u>NOT allowed</u> to visit at this time on the affected neighbourhoods, ONLY Essential Caregivers.** We kindly ask that everyone follow all Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) measures in place to help keep everyone safe and healthy while visiting.
- **Effective June 4, 2025, ALL Care Partners/Staff and Visitors MUST wear a mask when coming into Faith Manor, until** further notice. This is due to the current Covid-19 outbreak on Windmill and lighthouse Neighbourhood. We need to do our part in helping to stop the spread of infection in the home. Thank you all for your cooperation.
- * This document is updated as the situation changes (and not on the weekends) unless there is a significant change that requires communicating.
- * A reminder to all staff, tenants and visitors, please continue to monitor yourself for symptoms of COVID-19 and other respiratory illness at all times, <u>immediately</u> self-isolate if symptoms develop, do not visit the Manors or come to work if you are sick.

The safety of our residents, tenants, staff and visitors is our top priority. Therefore, it is critical that masks be worn properly at all times, frequent handwashing is done and all public health measures / posted signage are adhered to.

We will not tolerate any abuse of our staff who are enforcing these rules.
