

GRACE AND FAITH MANOR - ORGANIZATIONAL UPDATE

LAST UPDATE: January 16, 2026

GRACE MANOR:

- ❖ **There are no outbreaks in Grace Manor currently.**
- ❖ **General visitors can now resume their visits to Tulip Terrace. We still discourage your visit to any neighbourhood if you or your family members are on well. Please continue to follow hand hygiene and IPAC practices while visiting to keep yourselves and our residents safe and healthy.**
- ❖ **Universal masking is still applied at Grace Manor. All persons entering Grace Manor are required to wear a mask while visiting on ALL neighbourhood(s).**

FAITH MANOR:

- ❖ **Peel Public Health declared a Confirmed Respiratory Outbreak (Influenza A) in Faith Manor Sunshine neighbourhood on January 1, 2026.**
- ❖ **As of January 16, 2026, the outbreak continues in Faith Manor.**
- ❖ **No General Visitors are allowed on the outbreak neighbourhood(s), ONLY Essential Caregivers are allowed, but must wear a mask at all time and follow IPAC practices while visiting.**
- ❖ **All persons entering Faith Manor are required to wear a mask while visiting on ALL neighbourhood (s), regardless if their loved ones are on an outbreak unit or not.**
- ❖ **Please contact the Nurses on the affected neighbourhood(s), if you have any questions or clarifications.**

* **This document is updated as the situation changes (and not on the weekends) unless there is a significant change that requires communicating.**

* A reminder to all staff, tenants and visitors, please continue to monitor yourself for symptoms of COVID-19 and other respiratory illness at all times, immediately self-isolate if symptoms develop, do not visit the Manors or come to work if you are sick.

The safety of our residents, tenants, staff and visitors is our top priority. Therefore, it is critical that masks be worn properly at all times, frequent handwashing is done and all public health measures / posted signage are adhered to.
